Show Guidelines:

- KMSHA Show Rules Apply.
- Horses must be registered and certified with KMSHA/SMHA. Owners and exhibitors must have a current KMSHA membership. Exhibitors must have a current rider card.
- **2 Fun Classes do not require horse to be registered/certified; relaxed attire; must be 18 to show a stallion, do not count toward points
- Horse must complete a division class to qualify for the division championship – horse must complete an open class to qualify for the open championship, amateur rider must complete an amateur class to qualify for the amateur championship, youth rider must complete a youth class to qualify for the youth championship
- Must be 18 years old to show a stallion. Youth riders may only show in youth-designated classes. Exhibitors 11 and under must wear a helmet.
- Current negative coggins and health certificate required. No one on federal suspension may transport horses to the grounds or participate in the show except as a spectator.
- For classes with 4 horses or less, paybacks start at 2nd place; no payback for classes with one horse:
 - Regular Class - \$25...Paybacks \$25-\$15-\$10
 - Youth Championship - \$25...Paybacks \$25-\$15-\$10
 - Amateur Championship - \$40...Paybacks \$50-\$40-\$20
 - Division Championship - \$50...Paybacks \$150-\$50-\$25
 - Fun Classes** - \$10...Ribbons
- \$10 per horse per day inspection fee
- \$5 per person gate fee
